Lots of demonstrations will assist you in your efforts during these two days of fun, learning and skill stretching .

He worked mainly in the architectural field before forming [Douglas Boyd Services](#) in 1987. He has studied calligraphy with most of the biggest names on the calligraphy "who's who" list. Doug is highly regarded as a contemporary lettering artist for his traditional and cutting edge calligraphy work, and he is a sought after instructor in design, layout, calligraphy, and custom hand lettering.*
